Hearing

Background

The 2024-25 General Appropriations Act, H.B. 1, 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023 (Article II, HHSC, Rider 53) requires the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) to evaluate the rate-setting methodology for services reimbursable to grant recipients of the federal SABG funds. HHSC is also required to propose reimbursement rates for these services no later than October 1, 2023, in a format that will enable HHSC to receive public comments on the proposed rates.

Methodology

The proposed rates for federal SABG services are modeled through a pro forma costing approach. HHSC used costs for similar services, including Medicaid, commercial fee schedules, or other reliable data, to estimate the costs necessary to deliver services meeting federal and state requirements in accordance with Title 1 of the Texas Administrative Code (1 TAC) Section 355.101(c).

The proposed rates for federal SABG services also include methodologies aligned with Medicaid pricing methodologies, where applicable. Medicaid methodologies include a percentage of the Medicare rate, U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics data, Average Wholesale Pricing, and Medically comparable codes.
