Notice of Proposed Adjustments to Fees, Rates, or Charges for Ambulance Services, Birth and Women's Health Services, Evaluation and Management, and Private Duty Nursing

Adjustments are proposed to be effective September 1, 2023

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SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ADJUSTMENTS

To Be Effective September 1, 2023

Included in this document is information relating to the proposed adjustments to Medicaid payment rates for this legislatively directed Fee Review of (1) Ambulance Services, (2) Birth and Women's Health Services, (3) Evaluation and Management, and (4) Private Duty Nursing. The Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) intends to submit an amendment to the Texas State Plan for Medical Assistance under Title XIX of the Social Security Act to update the fee schedules to reflect these proposed adjustments. The rates are proposed to be effective September 1, 2023.

<u>Hearing</u>

The Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) will conduct a public hearing to receive comments regarding the proposed adjustments to Medicaid rates detailed in this document on July 11, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. The hearing will be held in compliance with Texas Human Resources Code §32.0282, which requires public notice of and hearings on proposed Medicaid reimbursements.

Background

HHSC is responsible for the reimbursement determination functions for the Texas Medicaid Program. Proposed rates are calculated utilizing established methodologies that conform to the Social Security Act and related federal regulations, the federally approved Texas Medicaid State Plan, all applicable state statutes and rules, and other requirements. HHSC reviews the Medicaid reimbursement rates for all acute care services every two years. These biennial reviews result in rates that are increased, decreased, or remain the same. The reviews are conducted to ensure that rates continue to be based on established rate methodologies.

<u>Methodology</u>

The specific administrative rules that govern the establishment of the fees in this proposal include these rules in the TAC:

- §355.8021, which addresses the reimbursement methodology for home health services;
- §355.8085, which addresses the reimbursement methodology for physicians and other practitioners;
- §355.8441, which addresses the reimbursement methodologies for Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT) services (known in Texas as Texas Health Steps);
- §355.8600, which addresses the reimbursement methodology for Ambulance Services; and
- §355.8641, which addresses the reimbursement methodology for the Women's Health Program.

Proposed Rate Adjustments

The 2024-25 General Appropriations Act, H.B. 1, 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023 [Article II, HHSC] directed the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) to increase reimbursement rates for the following:

- Rider 31 (a) directs HHSC to increase reimbursement rates for children's physician and clinic services (referred to as Evaluation and Management) by six percent.
- Rider 31 (b) directs HHSC to increase reimbursement rates for birth and women's health related surgeries by six percent.
- Rider 33 directs HHSC to increase reimbursement rates for ground ambulance mileage reimbursement by 25 percent.
- Rider 34 directs HHSC to increase reimbursement rates for private duty nursing by two percent.

Specific proposed payment rate adjustments are listed in the attachments outlined below:

- Att A(1) Ambulance Services
- Att A(2) Birth and Women's Health Services
- Att A(3) Evaluation and Management
- Att A(4) Private Duty Nursing

Potential Testimony Limitations

Due to the number of people anticipated to provide oral testimony at the hearing, HHSC may have to time-limit public testimony to three minutes for each individual depending on the number of participants signed-up to testify prior to the hearing and the time allotted for the rate hearing. HHSC will announce at the beginning of the hearing, the final allotted amount of time for oral testimony.

Written Comments

Written comments regarding the proposed payment rate adjustments will be accepted in lieu of, or in addition to, oral testimony until 5 p.m. the day of the hearing.
