Who Must Report?

- Local Governmental Entities (LGEs) ONLY NO Private Providers
- If your LGE dedicated local public funds for use as the nonfederal share for supplemental payments any time between October 1, 2022 – September 30, 2023. Either through:
 - Certified Public Expenditure (CPE) UC Ambulance, PHP-CCP, SHARS; or
 - Intragovernmental Transfer (IGT) DSH, UC, CHIRP, QIPP, TIPPS, RAPPS, HARP, GME, DSRIP, DPP BHS
 - If your entity did NOT provide CPE or IGT between October 1, 2022

 September 30, 2023, you do not need to remain on the line –
 email us at PFD_LFM@hhs.Texas.gov to explain your basis for exclusion.
