RE: Open Enrollment Period – July 1, 2014 to July 31, 2014 for ATTENDANT COMPENSATION RATE ENHANCEMENT

Dear Contracted Provider:

The Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) announces Open Enrollment for the Attendant Compensation Rate Enhancement Program for Community Care providers contracted with the Texas Department of Aging and Disability Services (DADS) as described in Title 1, Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §355.112. Community care providers who choose to participate in this optional program receive additional funds to provide incentives for increased wages and benefits for community care attendants and must demonstrate compliance with enhanced spending requirements on future cost reports.

To request participation or an increase in level, an Enrollment Contract Amendment (ECA) must be received by HHSC Rate Analysis Department <u>by July 31, 2014</u>. <u>No faxes will be accepted</u>. The ECA is to be completed online, printed out and signed by the authorized signatory that completed the form. The signed copy can be scanned and emailed to <u>acres@hhsc.state.tx.us</u> or mailed via certified, overnight or regular mail to HHSC Rate Analysis Department and must be received **no later than 5:00 pm on July 31, 2014**.
