Reminder – 3 More Training Sessions Remain for FFY 2015

Mandatory Annual Training for Independent School Districts
Medicaid Administrative Claiming

Federal Fiscal Year 2015
(October 2014 to September 2015)

Annual Medicaid Administrative Claiming (MAC) Financial training is mandatory for all independent school districts (ISDs) that wish to participate in the MAC program. MAC Financial training sessions are conducted by the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) Rate Analysis Division (RAD).

The MAC Financial Contact is required to attend an annual MAC Financial training in order to be granted access to the online MAC Financials for federal fiscal year (FFY) 2015. Failure to comply with this requirement will impact the ISD's ability to draw funding for MAC. There are only three more trainings available for FFY 2015. HHSC strongly recommends the district have at least two trained MAC Financial Contacts to ensure compliance should employee turnover occur.

Initial versus Refresher Training - Training requirements can be met by one of two methods. MAC Financial Contacts who have never attended MAC Financial ISD training must attend an initial training. Those who have received credit for an initial training may then attend either initial or refresher trainings yearly thereafter, to maintain access to the MAC financials. The training for MAC Financial Contacts is different than the training for RMTS Contacts. Although an overview of the MAC Financials is provided during the RMTS training, it is mandatory that the MAC Financial Contacts attend the separate MAC Financial training to be granted access to the online MAC financials for FFY 2015.
