RMTS annual training is mandatory for all Local Health Dept./Districts (LHD) that wish to participate in the Medicaid Administrative Claiming (MAC). Training sessions are conducted by the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC). Please remember, once an RMTS contact has successfully completed one training for the current fiscal year, they have met the requirement. If you have completed and received training credit any of the August 2022 – February 2023 trainings, you have fulfilled your annual training requirement and will not need to attend any more trainings for the rest of the FFY 2023. Training reminders will continue to be e-mailed to programs in the event additional staff want to be involved in the process.

It is crucial LHDs understand that compliance with the RMTS annual training requirement is mandatory. Failure to comply with this requirement will impact the LHD's ability to draw federal funding for MAC services provided. In addition, LHD's will not be given full access to the online time study system for FFY 2023 until the annual training requirement is met.

Beginning FFY 2023, Local Health Departments/Districts (LHD), Early Childhood Intervention (ECI) and Mental Health & Intellectual Developmental Disabilities (MH-IDD) will have combined initial and refresher trainings.

Training requirements can be met by one of two methods. RMTS Contacts who have never attended RMTS LHD training <u>must</u> attend "initial" training. Those who have attended an initial training may attend either initial or refresher training. See above website for additional details.
